

Parent File G 1448/Sale File WM 60492–Jefferson County 61.18 Acres

The Department acquired this parcel for \$2,300 in 1962. The parcel is part of the Extensive Wildlife Habitat project and is located in the Town of Farmington in Jefferson County.

There is an unnamed stream running through the property providing approximately 2670 feet of two bank frontage. The property is a lowland forest with good ash understory mixed with buckthorn.

The public can access the parcel through Krentz Road. There is moderate public use on the property for hunting.

The Natural Heritage Inventory (NHI) shows Slippershell Mussel and Blanding Turtle on the property.

The Department has not made significant investments in infrastructure or habitat improvements on the property. A timber sale is scheduled on the property.

The Department recommends that the Natural Resources Board offer this land for sale under the authority granted by s. 23.145 Wis. Stats., and that the land be offered subject to the timber contract.

Recommendation by the Natural Resources Board at the October 26, 2016 meeting directs the Department to retain this parcel.

Recommendation by the Natural Resources Board at the January 25, 2017 meeting directs the Department to offer this parcel for sale.
