Sandy Beach Lake Campground, sites 1901-1933, is in the northwest portion of then Northern Highland American Legion State Forest on the southeast corner of Sandy Beach Lake. A separate beach and picnic area is adjacent to the campground and has a large sandy beach and exquisite lake views. A boat landing is located just before the campground entrance. Sandy Beach Lake Campground offers large rustic sites and the chance to get closer to nature. **Camping reservations are required and can be made for the same day of your arrival or up to 11 months in advance of your planned date of occupancy. Campers must make a reservation before setting up on any site.**

A State Parks and Forest Admission sticker is **REQUIRED** year-round on vehicles in the campgrounds.

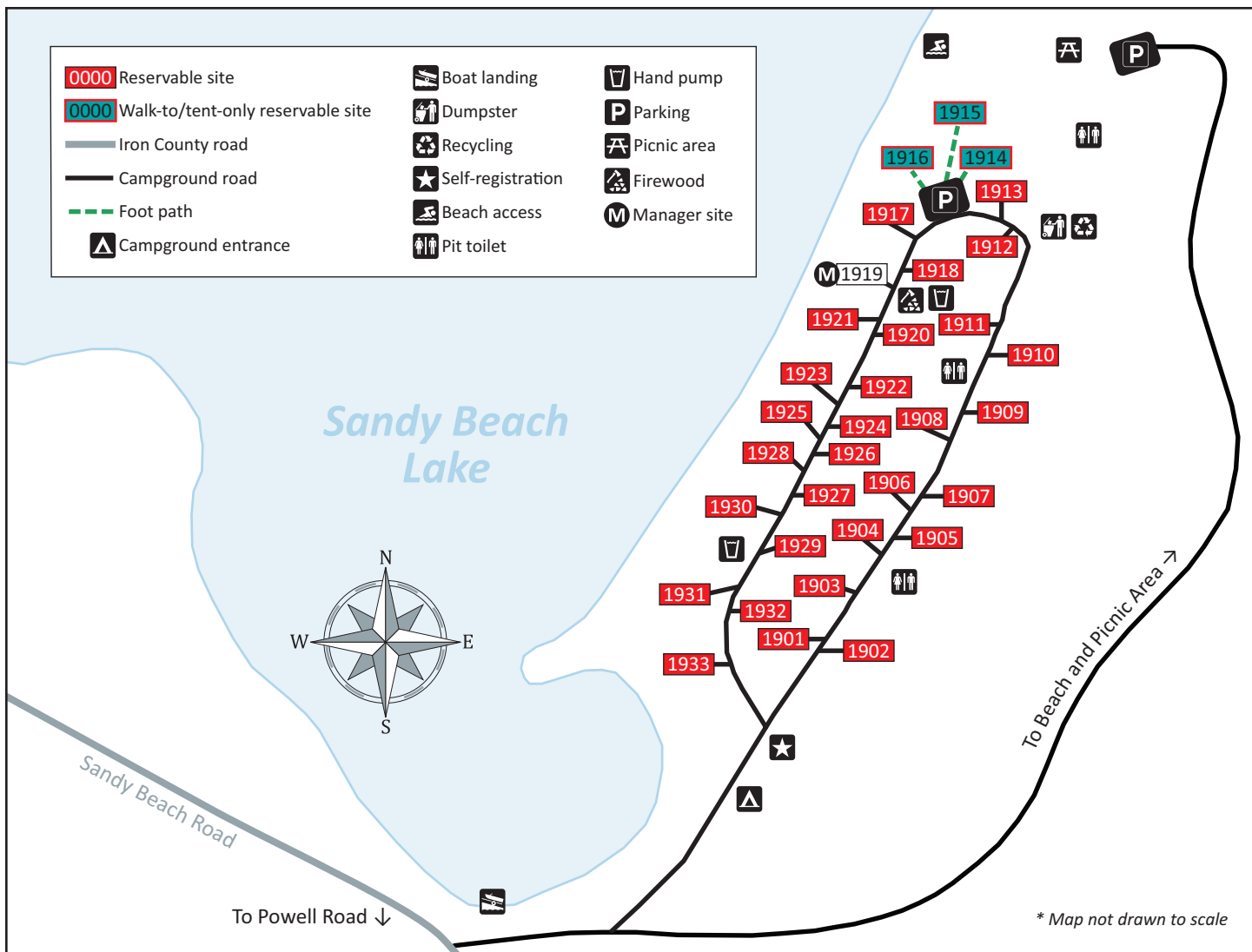

- **State Parks and Forest Admission Sticker required for camping**

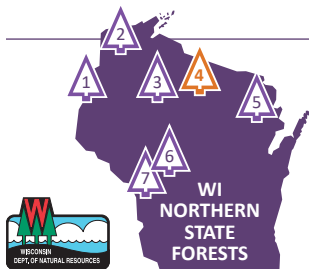

Campground Rules

- Upon arrival, all campers should proceed directly to their reserved campsite after the designated check-in time of 3 p.m.
- **Checkout Time:** Must vacate site by 3 p.m. on the last day of the permit.
- **Campground/Day-use Areas and Closing Time:** Campground closed to nonregistered campers 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- **Pets** must be on a leash at all times and not left unattended.
- **Noise** may not interfere with the enjoyment of the forest by others.
- **Generators** may be used from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- **Camping Party:** A “non-family group” may not exceed six persons. A “family” is limited to parents with their dependent children and not more than two guests.
- A **State Parks and Forest Admission Sticker** is required for camping.
- For complete rules and regulations, see Chapter NR 45, Wis. Admin. Code, or contact DNR Law Enforcement.
