



## HAZARDOUS WASTE AND/OR PCB TRANSPORTER LICENSE INFORMATION

Dear Hazardous Waste and/or PCB Transporter Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in becoming a licensed hazardous waste and/or PCB transporter in Wisconsin. This is an annual license with the license period beginning on October 1 and expiring on September 30. The annual license fee for a hazardous waste transporter is \$400. Unfortunately, by law we are unable to prorate this fee.

Please review Wisconsin regulations for the transportation of hazardous waste found in chapter NR 663 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code. A link to this chapter can be found on the *Waste Facility and Transporter Licenses* page at <https://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/Waste/Licenses.html>. These rules reference U.S. Department of Transportation regulations governing hazardous materials transportation. You are responsible for operating under both NR 663 and US DOT regulations.

If you also intend to be licensed as a "Full Service Contractor" of PCBs, you will need to have a minimum of \$300,000 in liability insurance. A copy of chapter NR 157, Wis. Adm. Code, covering the requirements for management of PCBs, is also available on the [Waste Facility and Transporter Licenses webpage](#) (link above).

The department is required by state statute to obtain each applicant's social security number, or, if the applicant is not an individual, the applicant's federal employer identification number (FEIN), before issuing or renewing a license. Please complete the following forms, where applicable, and send them to the appropriate [regional environmental program associate](#). To determine the correct regional office, please choose the region that includes the county where your vehicle(s) are stored. If your facility is located out of state, return your application materials to the regional office for the region in which the majority of your service will be provided, or the region that includes your point of entry to the State of Wisconsin.

- Proof of liability insurance for \$300,000 (if transporting PCB waste)

This license is subject to annual renewal applications and fees to remain current. You will be emailed the license renewal link and payment instructions each August.
