

## 2013-2014 Ceded Territory Walleye Bag Limits.

Inland waters not listed below have a total daily bag limit of 5, unless listed in the regulation pamphlet as a special regulation water. THESE BAG LIMITS ARE EFFECTIVE FROM MAY 4, 2013 TO MARCH 2, 2014 INCLUSIVE.

The total daily bag limit for walleyes is five. If the lake you are fishing has a bag limit less than five, you can fish other lakes to fill your daily bag limit. While fishing, you cannot possess fish in excess of that lake's daily bag limit. **Therefore, remember to remove all fish from your boat prior to fishing on a second lake that also has a restricted bag limit.**

**SPECIAL SIZE AND BAG LIMITS:**

**WALLEYE IN LAC DU FLAMBEAU RESERVATION WATERS:**

There is a bag limit of three and a minimum length limit of 18" for walleye on the following waters:

1. Shishebogama Lake, Oneida County;
2. Big Crooked Lake, T41N R5E S22, Vilas County;
3. Gunlock Lake, Vilas County;
4. Lac du Flambeau Chain, including Big Crawling Stone, Little Crawling Stone, Little Sand, Fence, Flambeau, Long, Interlaken, Moss, North Placid, Pokegama, South Placid, To-To-Tom, White Sand (T41N R5E S27) and Whitefish Lakes and all connecting waters, Vilas County;
5. Little Trout Lake, Vilas County.

**MUSKELLUNGE IN LAC DU FLAMBEAU RESERVATION WATERS:**

There is a minimum length limit for muskellunge of 40" on all waters that lie within the Lac du Flambeau reservation.
