Early Migratory Bird Season Proposals

September Early Teal Season (Proposed) **AP or Different**

Early Teal Season: Sept. 1 – Sept. 7 (6 bird/day) **AP or Different**

Early Goose Season: Sept. 1 – Sept. 15 (5 bird/day) **AP or Different**

Mourning Dove Season: Sept. 1 – Nov. 29 (15 bird/day) **AP or Different**

Woodcock Season: Sept. 22 – Nov. 5 (3 bird/day) **AP or Different**

60 Day Season – 6 ducks, no more than 4 mallards (only 1 may be a hen),
3 wood ducks, 1 black duck, 2 redheads, 3 scaup, **2 pintail** and 2 canvasback.
5 mergansers, not more than 2 hooded.
Coot daily bag of 15.

Youth Hunt: Sept. 15 and 16 **AP or Different**

North Zone: Sept. 29 – Nov. 27 **AP or Different**

South Zone: Sept. 29 – Oct. 7 & Oct. 13 – Dec. 2 (5 day split) **AP or Different**

Mississippi Zone: Sept. 29 – Oct. 5 & Oct. 13 – Dec. 4 (7 day split) **AP or Different**

Goose Season Dates

Exterior Zone: 92 days total. **Daily Bag of 3** **AP or Different**

Coot, Moorhen, Rails and Snipe: Same as wild ducks in the zone in which you are hunting.

Daily Bag Limit:

Coot and Moorhen – 15 **AP or Different**

Sora & Virginia Rails – 25 **AP or Different**

Snipe – 8 **AP or Different**
