Bluff Creek Workday

Enjoy the spring blooms and help control invasives at Bluff Creek SNA. Come see what's blooming and help volunteers during our monthly Southern Kettle Moraine SNA workdays on a Thursday workday. Enjoy a short hike through the woods to rare springs areas, then use sprayers to treat invasive brush. This work will remove invasive plants like garlic mustard and buckthorn, enlarging the woodland and rare plant communities. No skills needed you will be trained onsite.

Date: May 23 (Thursday)

Time: 9am-noon

Directions: Lone Tree parking lot. From Whitewater take Co Hwy P south past Hwy 12 about 2.5 miles and turn left on Esterly road. Travel a short distance and park on the parking lot on the east side of the road. Overflow parking along the road. [Google map](#)

What to wear: Dress for the weather and wear clothes that are OK to get beat up, long pants and long sleeves, boots- the hike could be a little mucky, safety glasses (we will have extra).

What to bring: Sunscreen, drinking water, bug spray.
