Please help to remove garlic mustard during the peak season of this highly invasive plant. Haskell Noyes is a premier southern mesic forest. The plant community here is threatened by the invasion of garlic mustard. Haskell Noyes is located in the Kettle Moraine State Forest – Northern Unit.

Directions:

From State Highway 45 and County Road SS take SS east through New Prospect and turn right on County Road GGG. Parking lot is on the right a short distance from the intersection with GGG. Directions will be posted at the parking lot as to where we will be working if you can't come right at 5 pm during the week or 9 am on Saturdays.

What to wear: Wear work clothes: long pants, long sleeves, gloves and sturdy footwear. Garbage bags will be provided.

What to bring: Drinking water
