Orange Trail	0.5 mi / 0.9 km	more difficult
Blue Trail	0.7 mi / 1.2 km	more difficult
Pink Trail	2.9 mi / 4.8 km	easy
Black Trail	Paved path to beach	more difficult

Winter Trail System Use:
Classic-only ski trails: Yellow, Green, Purple, Orange
Winter use and directional designations apply to the classic ski trails once the trails are snowcovered and groomed. NO hiking, snowshoeing, skate skiing, skijoring or pets are allowed on these trails.

Multi-use trails: Red, Blue, Brown, Pink, Black
Hiking, snowshoeing, skate or classic sking, skijoring and pets are allowed on these trails.
