Saturday October 12 Cemetery Walk 10 – 11 AM. Meet at Weborg day use parking lot. Discover Door County history and mysteries on a naturalist-led walk. Tree and fall flower identification featured, too. Easy walking. Less than half-a-mile.

Saturday October 19 Eagle Panorama to Eagle Terrace 10 -11 AM. Meet at Eagle Panorama overlook. Tree facts and folklore, park history, and geology featured on a naturalist-led, mile long hike. Tower news, too. Trail may have slippery spots.

Saturday October 26 The park naturalist will be hosting a table at the Gibraltar Fire and Rescue's annual **fire safety open house** event. Tours and kids games featured. Location: 3496 County Road F. Approximate hours of event are 10 AM to 2 PM.

Friday November 29 Eagle Panorama to Eagle Terrace 10 -11 AM. Meet at Eagle Panorama overlook. Tree facts and folklore, park history, and geology featured on a naturalist-led, mile long hike.
