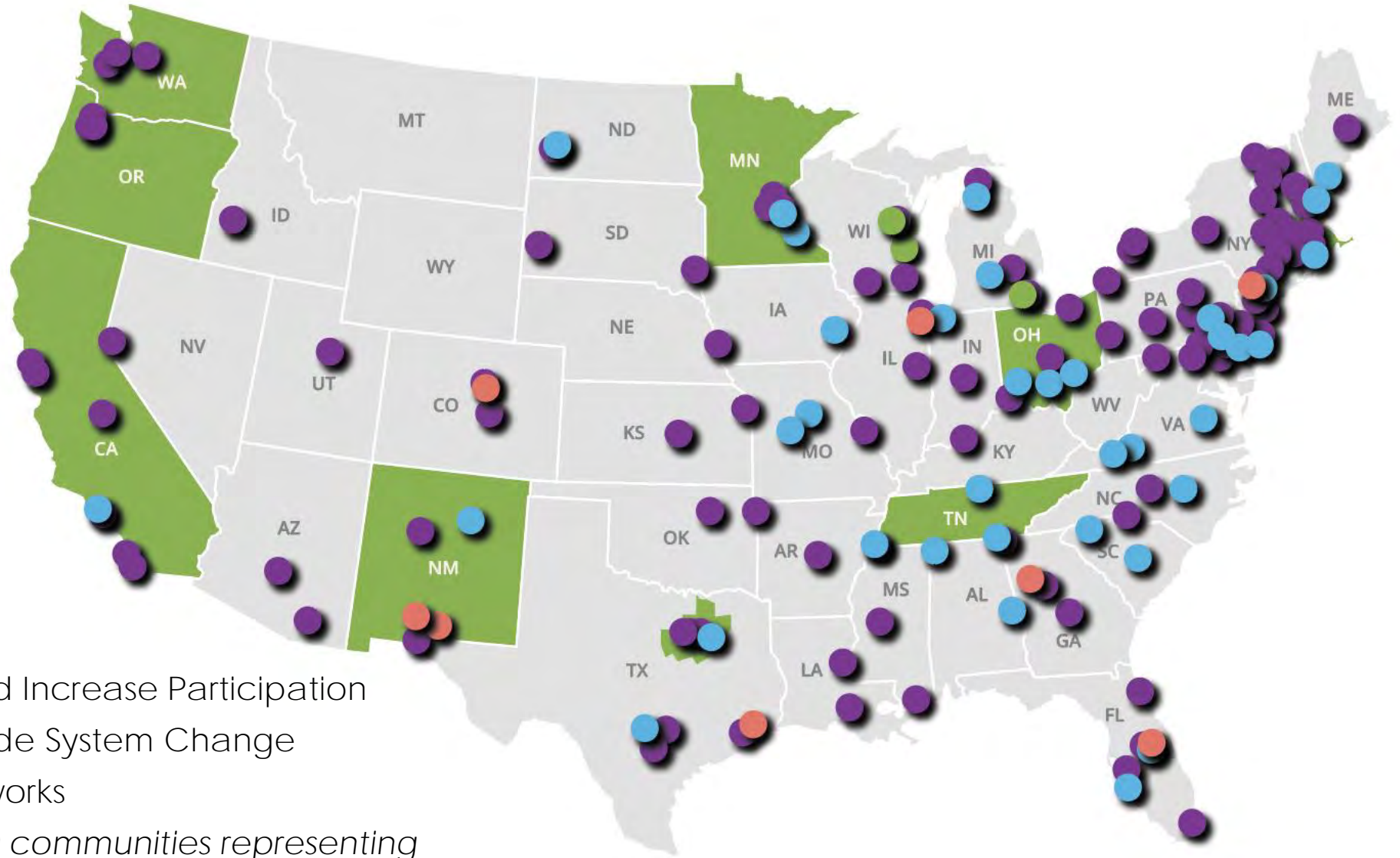

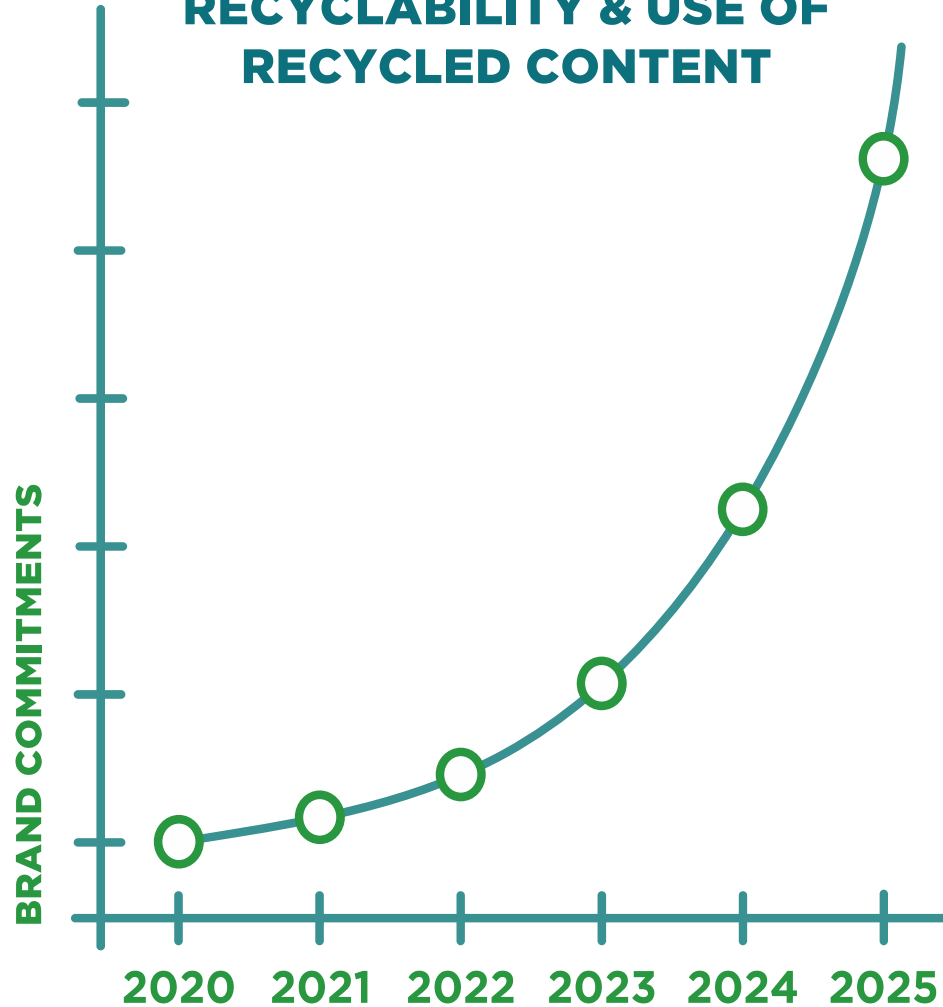
Additionally, more than 500 communities representing 30 million households have downloaded our free videos, campaigns, social media kits and tech tools.

Expedite innovative public-private solutions.



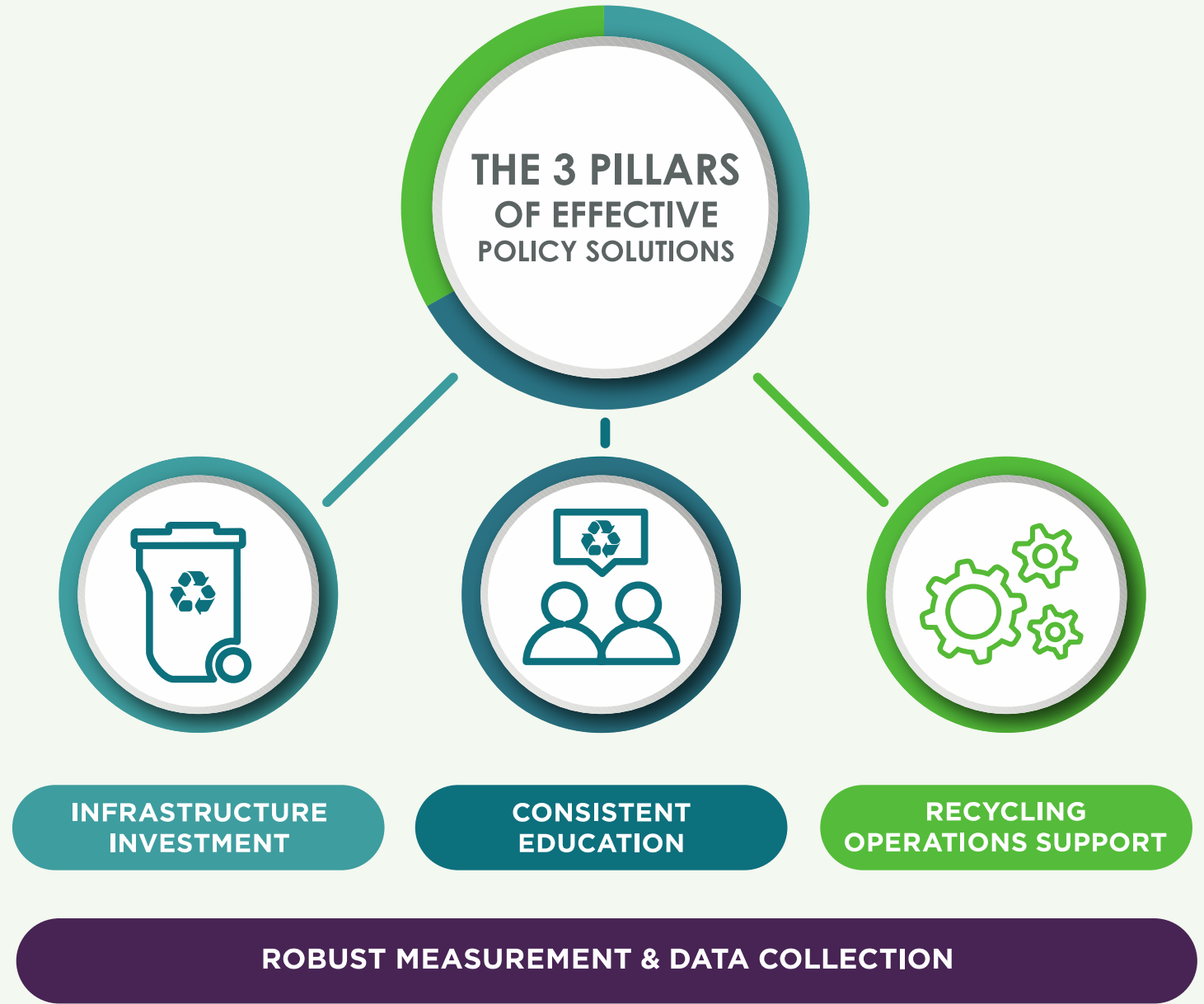

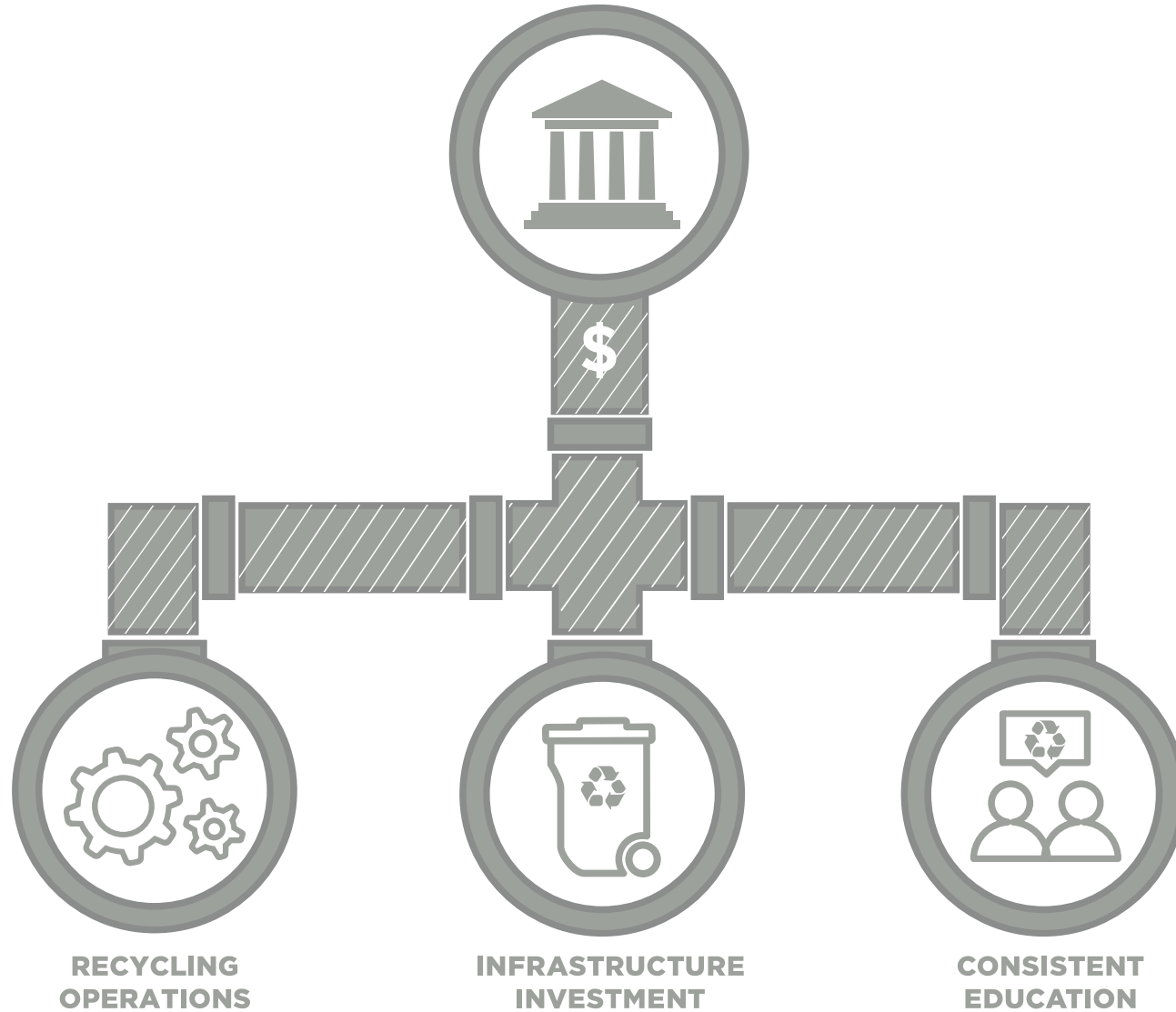

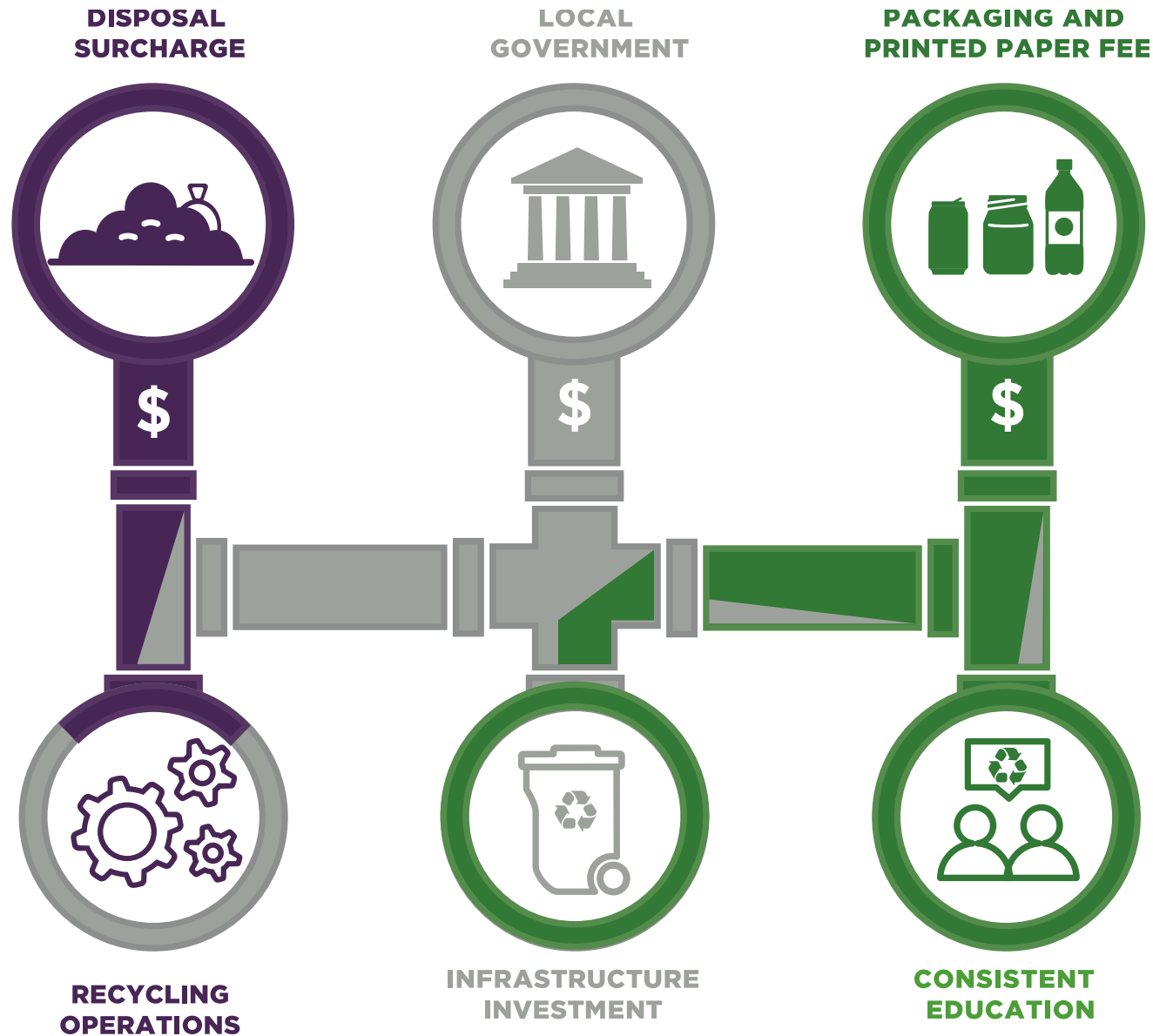

How It Works: Current System

Local governments bear all burden of funding residential recycling, and it's not enough to sustain or improve the system.



How It Works: Proposed System

Funding is injected from private-sector packaging and printed paper fees and public-sector disposal surcharges to sustain and improve the system.

Public Sector Advisory Group

Engaging state and local government stakeholders in discussions to refine, improve, and advance policy solutions, including those outlined in the *Accelerating Recycling* policy report.
