



Preliminary 9-Day Opening Weekend Comparison, 2018 vs. 2019

This is a comparison of 2018 and 2019 9-day opening weekend deer registration data by deer management zone (DMZ), deer management unit (DMU), and deer type (antlered versus antlerless). The comparison includes deer killed with a gun during the 9-day gun deer hunting season; no crossbow or archery harvest are included. Deer harvested with deer damage tags, Deer Management Assistance Program antlerless tags, CWD Surveillance tags and other types of special permit are included.
