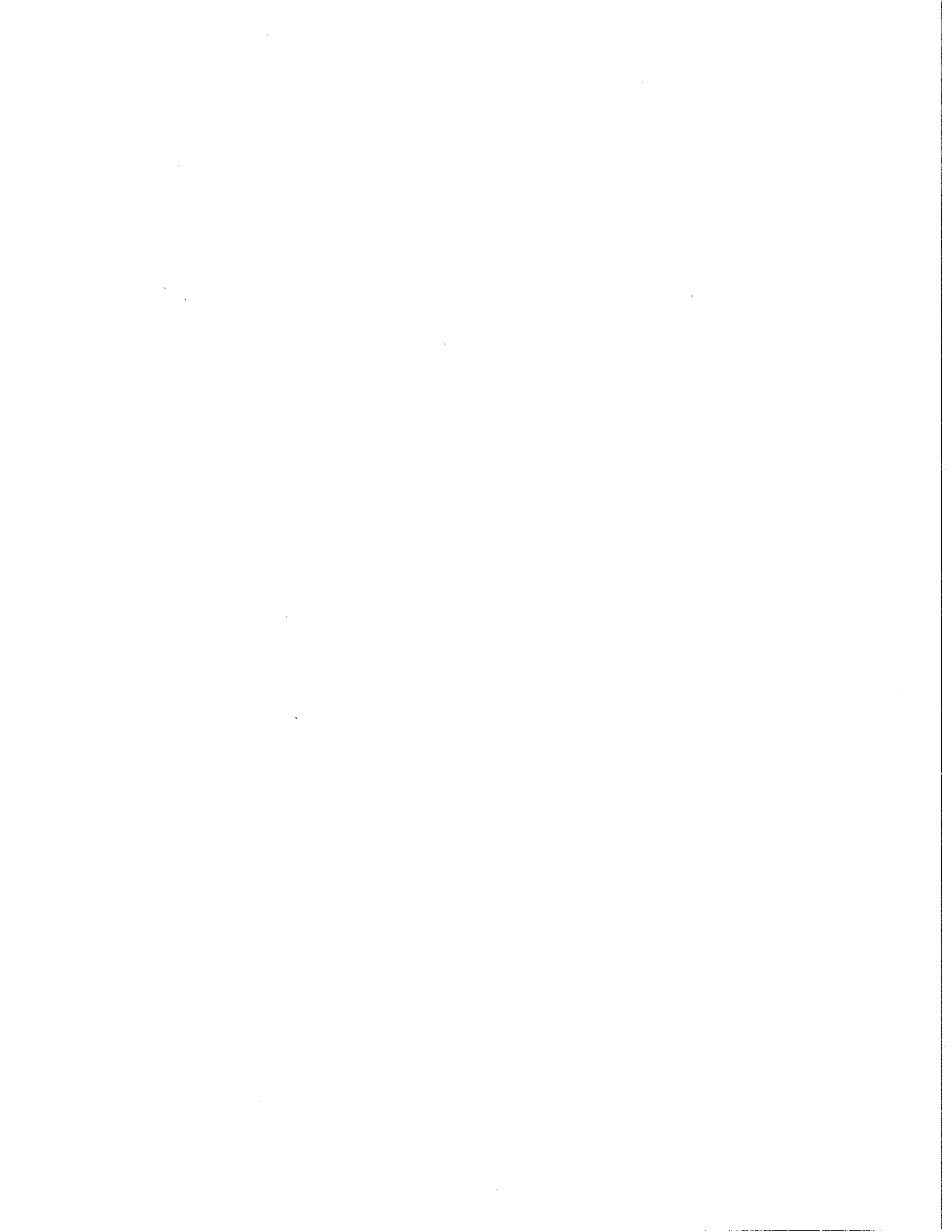


Mike Ederer, left, and Mike Kuchar trade golf bags for a canoe Thursday at Lake Windsor Country Club.

SUBJECT: Follow-up contact for November 19, 1991 Community Assistance Visit

The purpose of this letter is to serve as a follow-up to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Community Assistance Visit (CAV) held in your community on November 19, 1991.

The letter to your community dated December 16, 1991, from Mr. Ken Christopherson of this Department, identified the following issues for further community action:

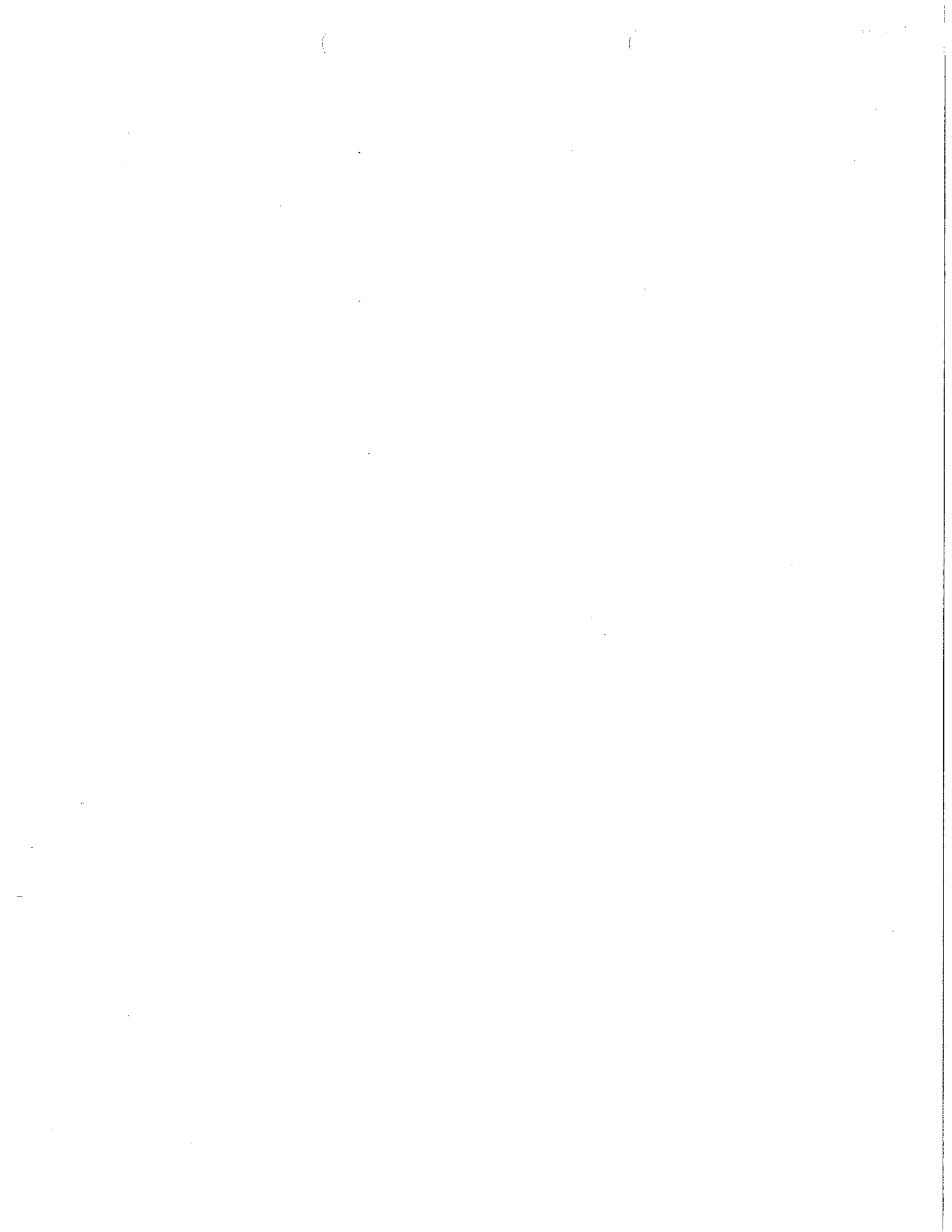
Ordinance:

- 1. County needs to update their FZO to meet current NR 116, Wis. Admin. Code and FEMA standards (includes all revisions since County's last major revision in 1978). County to amend ordinance by May 1992.

Maps:

- 1. FEMA maps do not contain floodplain delineations for several streams and rivers within the County. There are also several areas which presently have floodplains delineated but have no corresponding flood elevations. Updated maps should also include section lines, section corners, section numbers, streets, street names and revise areas of annexation.


As of this date our records indicate that these issues have not been resolved. Please respond in writing to this office within thirty (30) days to identify what action your community will initiate to correct the noted issues. If your community has already completed action to resolve these issues please forward a copy of the pertinent information to this office so that we may update our files. If there are additional issues that you would like to bring to our attention, which were not addressed in the CAV, please include those items in your response letter.

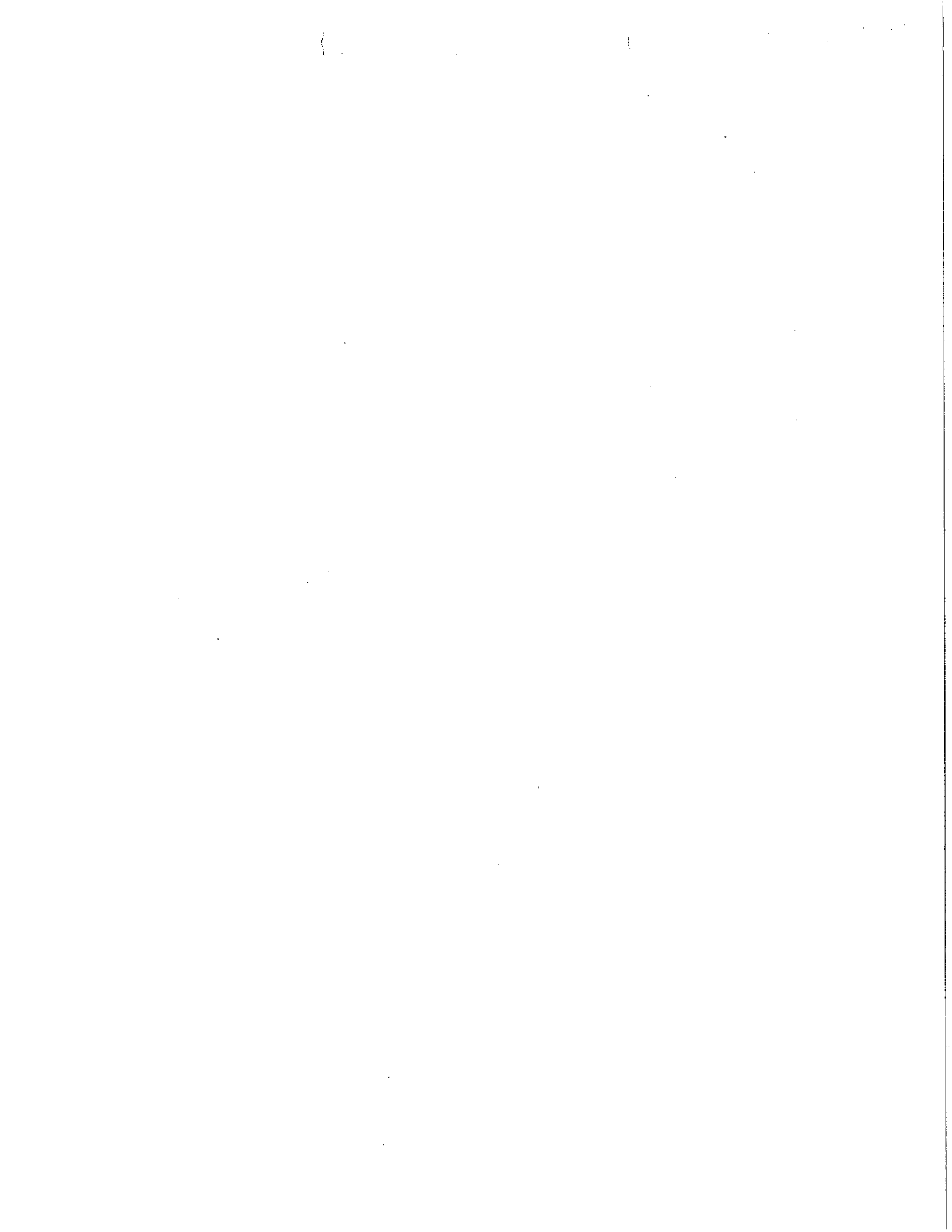


Dear Mr. Larson:

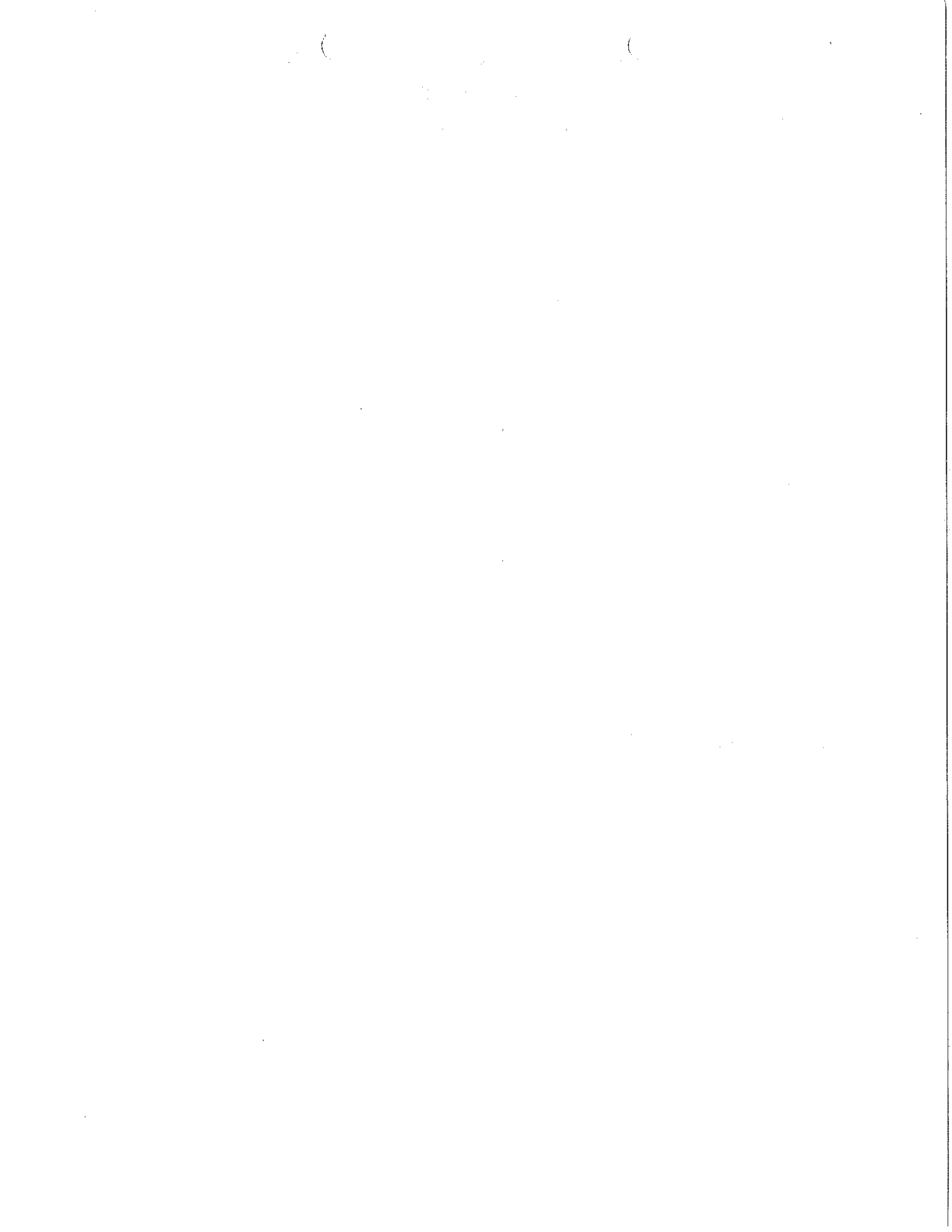

Dear Mr. Fleck:

Thank you for sending in a response memorandum which addressed your community's actions regarding the Community Assistance Visit (CAV) issues outlined in my letter dated March 12, 1993. The purpose of this letter is follow-up on amendment of your community's floodplain zoning ordinance to incorporate updates in the state's NR 116 Wis. Admn. Code and Federal Rules relating to the National Flood Insurance Program.

As the Department is contractually obligated to report to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) on the status of all CAV's, I am requesting your assistance to provide a time-table for adoption of these amendments to your ordinance. In addition, the Bureau Floodplain Engineer, Mr. Dean Stitgen, will be contacting you regarding any FEMA restudy or mapping issues.
