

- Annual site visits to check beetle populations
- Beetle Rearing
  - 2 mass rearing stations:
  - Produced approximately 60,000 beetles and released at various sites throughout BC
  - St. Croix Tribe joined the effort and will raise their own beetles next year to release on the Yellow River, St. Croix River, Bashaw Lk and Rice Lake.
- Cutting and spraying several sites throughout Burnett County
  - See Map
- Conducted 2 CLP surveys on Middle and Big McKenzie
- Conducted 2 Plant surveys on Middle and Big McKenzie
- Collected, vouchered and pressed over 104 aquatic plant species
- Writing an Aquatic Macrophyte Report
- Working with the McKenzie Lake Association to develop and APM
- Working jointly with DNR on plant surveys.
- Obtained Volunteers to conduct Secchi disk readings and chemical analysis on Middle McKenzie.
- Held and AIS workshop in June and trained 27 people on how to identify the 12 most common AIS.
- Working with the tribe on the carp situation in Clam Lake
- Conducted a workshop and the Webster Library.
- 2 interns conducting CBCW
- CBCW – plant survey at the landings, check for AIS, GPS each landing and including digital pics of boat landing. Creating a data base.
