

**WDNR WATER QUALITY PLANNING PROGRAM PROGRESS REPORT – JULY, 2014
EAST CENTRAL WISCONSIN REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION**

SSA Plan Updates & Mapping

East Central staff continued to work on the Fond du Lac, Eden and Oakfield SSA Plan Updates as follows:

- Staff met with officials from the Town of Oakfield Sanitary District, Town of Oakfield and Village of Oakfield to discuss the population and housing unit projections developed for the 2035 plan update. In addition, population and housing unit projections were also developed and presented to the Village of Eden regarding their 2035 SSA plan update. Base mapping refinements for both service areas was performed. Also reviewed were the existing and future land use summaries.
- Communities within the Fond du Lac SSA continue to negotiate the Outlying Sewer Group Agreement debating issues involving a financial payment structure, phosphorous reduction regulations, plant capacity concerns, TMDL issues, wastewater metering for various users of the system and on-going sewer infrastructure needs determinations. Staff continues to monitor this project and offers input to the process as needed. It is anticipated this project will be a work in progress for calendar year 2014.

East Central staff continued to work on other SSA issues as follows:

- Staff attended the Town of Omro Plan Commission meeting to discuss zoning issues with respect to sewer service area planning. Certified survey mapping and the process of splitting parcels was one topic discussed. The Town of Omro intends to amend their zoning ordinance to better reflect the conditions and development trends within the town and to ascertain sewer service provision for future areas.
- Staff held a “pre-review” meeting with private consultants and the Village of Harrison to discuss requirements needed to lift a sewer extension hold area from the Heart of the Valley Sewer Service Area. It is anticipated the Village of Harrison will commission a feasibility study to address the sewer extension hold area.
- Staff did a follow-up with the City of Brillion by submitting a correction page, (inside the cover), for the recently adopted 2030 Brillion Sewer Service Area Plan.

East Central staff continued to work on the Fond du Lac, Oakfield and Eden SSA Plan Updates as follows:

- Staff updated the Compliance Maintenance Annual Report for both the Eden and Oakfield SSA's. This technical data was incorporated into both plans as the draft documents are being assembled. The various support tables are being formatted to include as part of the document editing process.
- The Fond du Lac SSA plan continues on standby until the Outlying Sewer Group Agreement is finalized.

East Central staff continued to work on other SSA issues as follows:

- Staff completed the summary of proceedings from the June 11, 2014 Community Facilities Committee meeting.
- Staff filled a sewer service area data request for the WDNR Bureau of Drinking and Groundwater involving Outagamie, Waupaca, Winnebago and Shawano Counties.
- Staff filled a sewer service area and planning area boundary data request for the Department of Revenue regarding the Shawano Sewer Service Area.
- Staff reviewed and commented on the Village of Harrison's Sewer Feasibility Study as support documentation for lifting a sewer extension hold area in the 2030 Heart of the Valley SSA.

East Central staff continued to work on the sewer service area activities for the Fond du Lac, Eden and Oakfield updates as follows:

- Staff met with the Village of Oakfield to discuss priority development areas and allocation projections based on the existing and future land use summaries. The result of this meeting was mapped and acreage areas quantified for comparison to residential and industrial acreage needs. Based on this information additional support tables were developed for inclusion in the final plan document.
- The Fond du Lac Outlying Sewer Group committee continues to meet, (monthly), with their Executive and technical Committees. These committees are dealing with a wide range of issues as they continue to update an agreement between all the sewer providers in the Fond du lac Sewer Service Area.

- Staff prepared for and held a Community Facilities Committee meeting in which the committee heard a presentation by the Village of Harrison to lift the sewer extension hold area within the 2030 HOV SSA. Committee action placed this issue on the agenda for the October, 2014 committee meeting. .
- Staff met with the Town of Ellington, (Stephensville Sanitary District), to discuss the status of their wastewater treatment system and to discuss a potential development proposal adjacent to the Town of Greenville. The focus as to avoid private on-sites within or in close proximity to the 2030 Grand Chute-Menasha West SSA.
- Staff had similar discussions with a developer/consultant regarding private on-site systems within the 2030 Heart of the Valley SSA, (Village of Harrison).
- Staff attended a tour of Collins Marsh as part of the North Branch Manitowoc River Watershed flood study.
