**Subject: Satisfaction of Category III Notice of Discharge**

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Rehn:

The Department of Natural Resources (Department) received documentation on July 8, 2015 confirming that you have completed the actions necessary to fulfill a Notice of Discharge issued to your operation on April 24, 2013 for manure spreading impacts to groundwater. At this time, the action of developing a nutrient management plan satisfies the conditions of the Notice of Discharge.

However, any future discharges of polluted runoff into waters of the state will be in violation of Chapter NR 243, Wisconsin Administrative Code and subject to escalated enforcement action. To reduce this possibility, the Department recommends that you carefully follow your nutrient management plan and follow all appropriate restrictions when land applying manure during frozen or snow covered conditions. Note that the Notice of Discharge required that you no longer spread manure on field #22 during frozen or snow-covered conditions. Submit annual updates of your nutrient management plan to the Shawano County Land Conservation Department by the date they establish.
