Dear Mr. Polzin:

Upon review of the attached ordinance, our number 588, we find it to be consistent with ss. 30.50 to 30.71 of the Wisconsin Statutes and Department rules adopted to implement those sections. Please submit a signed copy of the ordinance upon passage. As outlined in s. 30.77(4), Wis. Stats., no ordinance is valid until it is prominently posted at all access points within your jurisdiction and until a signed copy is received by this office.

Please note the posting requirements outlined in NR 5.15, Wisconsin Administrative Code, which require a sign with a minimum of three inch lettering be posted at each public landing outlining all regulations more restrictive than state law.

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

The Belle Plaine town board does ordain as follows:

1. **AUTHORITY.** The board acts according to authority granted in Chapter 30 of Wisconsin Statutes, including ss. 30.50 to 30.71 in its entirety, and for the health, safety and welfare of its citizens pursuant to its village powers.

2. **PURPOSE.** The board finds that **SCHOENROCK LAKE** has fewer than 50 surface acres, but is not subject to s. 30.635 on slow-no-wake state restriction, due to lack of a public access point. This ordinance is approved with the goal of increasing safety and protecting the lake from pollution, overcrowding and conflict among users.

3. **MOTOR RESTRICTION.** No person shall operate any watercraft propelled by an internal combustion fuel motor. Electric motors are allowed.

4. **NOTICE.** This ordinance regulation shall be placed at a prominent lake site chosen after public hearing and comment by area owners affected.

5. **PENALTIES.** Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in s. 30.80, Wis. Stats., and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference with all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.


Dear Ms. Crawford:
