

SWIMMING AREA ORDINANCE

235

The Town of Rome Board of Supervisors of the County of Adams, State of Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a swimming area and provide safe and enjoyable aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource pursuant to Section 30.77(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2. Applicability and Enforcement. The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Lake Arrowhead within the jurisdiction of the Town. The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the officers of the police of the Town of Rome.

Section 3. State Boating and Water Safety Laws Adopted. The statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to water traffic, boats, boating and related water activities and safety found in the following enumerated section of the Wisconsin Statutes are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance.

30.68(7) Restricted Areas

Section 4. Area Designated. The area designated as a swimming area shall be as follows:

That area abutting the following described lands: That part of the NW¼ NW¼ Section 13, Township 20 North, Range 5 East described as being west of Lake Arrowhead, east of 15th Avenue and south of the Lake Arrowhead dam.

The area shall be designated by buoys which meet the standards set in Wisconsin Administrative Code NR 5.09.

Section 5. Penalty Section. Any person who shall violate any provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit first offense, \$25.00 plus costs; second offense, within one year of first offense, \$50.00 plus costs; third offense and any further offenses within one year of the first, \$100.00 plus costs. Note: Any offense preceded by at least one year without an offense shall be considered a first offense.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance is effective upon passing and posting of this ordinance.
