

ORDINANCE NO. _____

ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO SILVER LAKE:

The Common Council of the City of Portage does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 12-2-2(c) is hereby renumbered to 12-2-2(d).

12-2-2(c) is hereby recreated to read as follows:

No person shall operate a boat or personal water craft faster than slow-no-wake within 50 feet of the boat landing or the bridge on Silver Lake, at any time of the day.

12-2-7 is hereby renumbered to 12-2-8.

12-2-7 is hereby recreated to read as follows:

12-2-7 Miscellaneous Restrictions

(a) No person shall jump, dive or enter the water within 20 feet of the bridge from Silver Lake. No person shall swim within 20 feet of the bridge.

(b) No person shall swim, wade, jump, dive, enter or be in the water within 20 feet of the boat landing other than and incidental to put in or remove a boat from the water. No person shall interfere with the launching or landing of any boat or water craft within that area.

(c) No persons shall stand in the road right of way for the purpose of fishing, above the East side of the bridge.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication thereof.
