
2005 Fish Net Deployment – Article 405

The City of Crystal Falls installed the fish net on May 13, 2005. On June 17, at 10:00 am the river flow had exceeded 850 cfs and the fish net was removed. On June 21, at 2:30 pm the river flow receded to less than 850 cfs and the fish net was installed. On September 26, 2005 the fish net was removed for the duration of the year.

All deployment and removal dates were in accordance to the license agreement.

**Exotic Species Annual Monitoring Report**

Dear Ms. Magalie R. Salas:

On July 27, 2005, Crystal Falls city employee Dave Graff and MDNR's Arnold Abramson canoed the shoreline from a point approximately 1.5 miles upstream of the dam down to the boat landing on the eastern shore of the impoundment. Areas between the boat landing and Fairbanks Road were visually inspected from the shore.

No individual or populations of either loosestrife or Eurasian water milfoil were found.
