Whiting Hydroelectric Project, FERC No. 2590 - Article 407, Purple Loosetrife Monitoring Biennial Report - 2003

Dear Ms. Salas:

In accordance with the order approving and modifying the Purple Loosetrife Monitoring Report, Consolidated Water Power Company (CWPCo) is filing the biennial report on the last two years monitoring efforts.


CWPCo conducted monitoring in 2000 and again in 2001 on the above Project. The most recent inspection was concluded in August 2003. Inspections were completed by vehicle and boat (where necessary). Smaller colonies were removed to the best extent possible while any larger colonies would be mapped and monitored. A Purple Loosetrife publication (PUBL-WM-250-95) provided by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources is provided to the public when the request copies of our recreation map. These continue to be distributed.

Previous monitoring identified two small sites on islands within the project boundary. These are identified on the attached map as sites number one (1) and two (2). Both sites were less than fifteen plants and mechanical removed to the best possible extent. The same sites were observed in 2003. No other sites were observed.

CWPCo will continue with the annual monitoring and biennial reporting. The next report is due to the FERC in October, 2005.
