ORDER AMENDING LICENSE
(ISSUED MARCH 27, 1992)

On January 27, 1992, the licensee for the Midtec Project No. 10674 requested that the license for the project be modified to change the name of the licensee from Midtec Paper Corporation to Repap Wisconsin, Inc. The licensee also requests that the project name be changed to the Kimberly Project to avoid confusion.

Background

On September 27, 1991, the Commission issued a license to the Midtec Paper Corporation for the Midtec Project (56 FERC ¶ 62,226). The project is located at the south end of the United States-owned Cedars Lock and Dam, on the Fox River in Outagamie County, Wisconsin.

On October 10, 1991, the shareholders of the Midtec Paper Corporation approved an amendment to the Certificate of Incorporation to change the name of the corporation to Repap Wisconsin, Inc. As a result, all business and property formerly held in the name of Midtec Paper Corporation is now held by Repap Wisconsin, Inc. The name change is substantiated in a copy of the "Certificate of Amendment of Certificate of Incorporation for Midtec Paper Corporation" issued by the state of Delaware and provided to the Commission.

The licensee states that, notwithstanding the formal corporate name change, the identity of the licensee and the personnel responsible for the project operation remain unchanged. The licensee also states that the name change does not affect the licensee's qualification as a person eligible to be a licensee under the Federal Power Act. We agree. The grant of this amendment request will approve a change of corporate name only, will conform the formal identity of the licensee to the name listed on its Certificate of Incorporation, and will have no impact on the project or its operations.¹ The request to amend the license to change the project name to avoid confusion also will be granted.

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The Di rector orders:

(A) The name change request filed by the Midtec Paper Corporation on January 27, 1992, is granted.

(B) Ordering Paragraph (A) of the license issued September 27, 1991, for the Midtec Project No. 10674 is revised to delete the name Midtec Paper Corporation and substitute in place thereof the name Repap Wisconsin, Inc.

(C) Ordering Paragraph (A) of the license issued September 27, 1991, to Midtec Paper Corporation is revised to delete the name Midtec Project and substitute in place thereof the name Kimberly Project.

(C) This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
