ORDER AMENDING LICENSE

(August 25, 2015)

1. On August 17, 2015, Thilmany, LLC licensee for the De Pere Hydroelectric Project, FERC No. 4914,¹ filed a notice advising the Commission that they had changed its name to Expera Specialty Solutions, LLC, effective June 26, 2013. Thilmany, LLC states that this is a change of name only and that there has been no change in the legal entity holding the license for the De Pere Hydroelectric Project. The project is located at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' (Corps) De Pere Dam on the Fox River in the City of De Pere in Brown County, Wisconsin. The project does not occupy any United States land.

2. This change is administrative and does not change any other conditions or requirements of the project. The licensee should ensure that all of the references to "Thilmany, LLC" are changed, including but not limited to, the project's Part 8 signs, any safety signs with the licensee name on them, and any other directional signs. The project should reflect the new licensee name "Expera Specialty Solutions, LLC." The licensee's request to change its name is approved.

The Director orders:

(A) The license for the De Pere Hydroelectric Project is amended to change the licensee's name from Thilmany, LLC to Expera Specialty Solutions, LLC.

(C) This order constitutes final agency action. Any party may file a request for rehearing of this order within 30 days from the date of its issuance, as provided in section (§) 313(a) of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 8251 (2012), and the Commission's regulations at 18 C.F.R. § 385.713 (2015). The filing of a request for rehearing does not operate as a stay of the effective date of this order, or of any other date specified in this order. The licensee's failure to file a request for rehearing shall constitute acceptance of this order.
