Can I Do That?

- Do Adaptive Management while working on establishing trades
- Trade within my community
- Get a compliance schedule for MDV interim limits
- Use MDV while establishing my trades
- Use MDV after my trades are established
- Continue to be covered under MDV when reductions get me to 0.3 mg/L concentration
- Remove sediment of my upstream millpond for trade credits
- Treat my upstream millpond for phosphorus for Adaptive Management
- Do Adaptive Management on upstream tributaries of my lake
- Trade my TMDL allocation and apply for a MDV
- Use site specific criteria to change my TMDL allocation
- Get my discharge reclassified to a wetland and not have phosphorus limits
- Move my discharge to a wetland and not have phosphorus limits
