

RESOLUTION RPC NO. 233

AMENDING THE DANE COUNTY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION
LAND USE PLAN TO REFINE THE URBAN SERVICE AREA
FOR THE VILLAGE OF OREGON

WHEREAS, the Dane County Regional Planning Commission has adopted a Land Use Plan (Resolution RPC No. 109) as a part of the Master Plan of Dane County, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, said plan contains Map A which delineates Urban Service Areas and which are indicated as being suggested only until such time as agreement has been reached between the Dane County Regional Planning Commission and the local unit of government; and


WHEREAS, the Village worked with the staff of the Dane County Regional Planning Commission to refine the Urban Service Area of the County Land Use Plan and the Village has adopted certain revisions to reflect local considerations, but are consistent with the purpose and intent of the adopted County Land Use Plan;

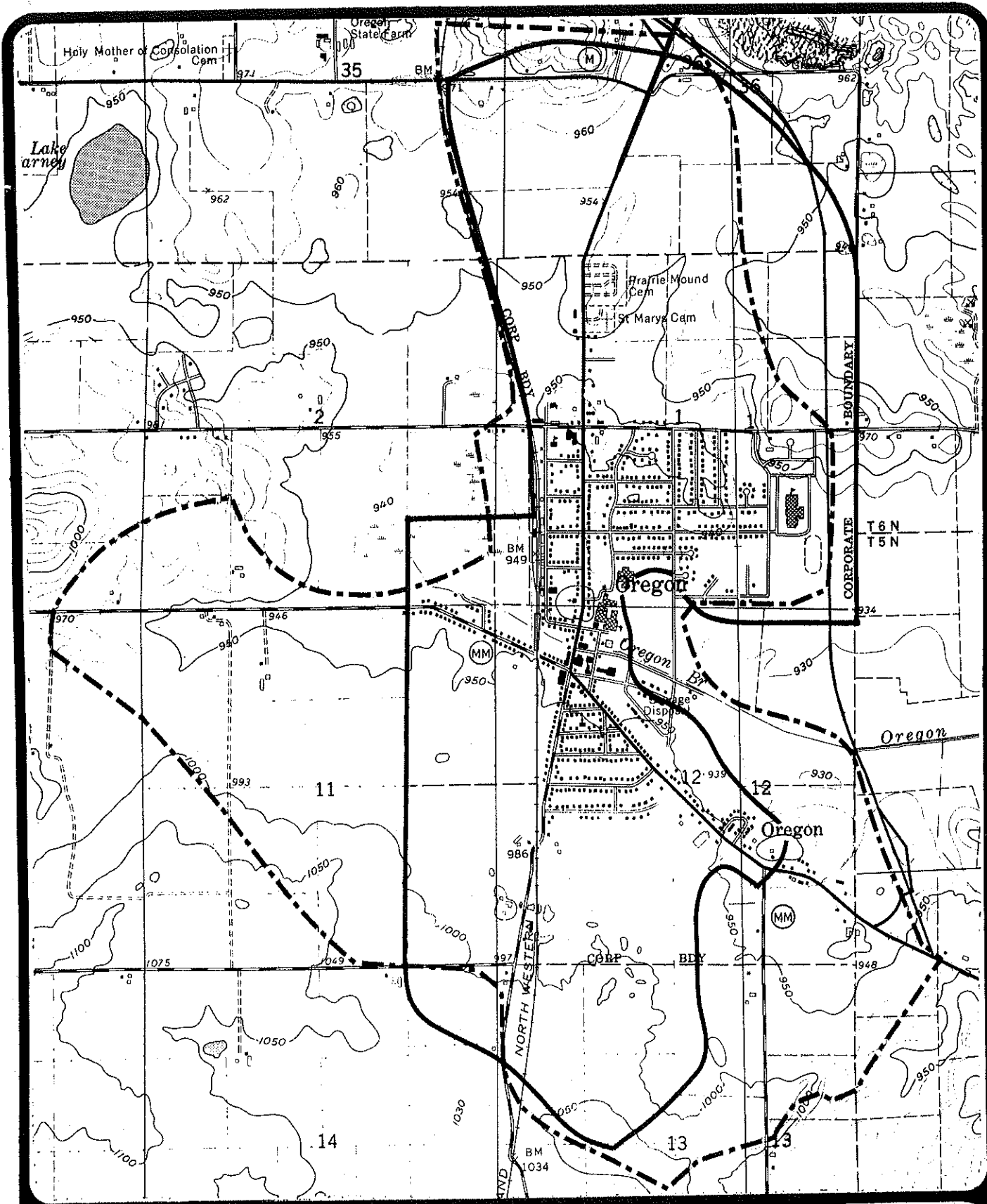
