RE: Amendment to the *Dane County Water Quality Plan* Revising the Cross Plains Urban Service Area Boundary and Environmental Corridors

Dear Ms. Helmuth:

We are submitting an amendment to the *Dane County Water Quality Plan*, revising the Cross Plains Urban Service Area boundary and environmental corridors, for Department review and approval.

This amendment was requested by the Village of Cross Plains. The amendment adds six acres to the Cross Plains Urban Service Area, including 0.8 acres of environmental corridors and 0.2 acres of existing development. The amendment also deletes 1,700 lineal feet of environmental corridor (13.7 acres), and adds 1.6 acres of environmental corridors in the current urban service area. The net result is an increase of 17.1 acres of developable land in the Cross Plains USA. The amendment is on land in the Village of Cross Plains, and is proposed to accommodate residential and commercial development. You will note that the resolution adopting this change contains requirements for stormwater management measures to protect the water quality of nearby water resources.

Enclosed are two copies of the following supporting materials: (1) request from the Village of Cross Plains; (2) public hearing notice; (3) staff analysis of the proposed amendment (dated June 18, 1998); (4) minutes of the June 25, 1998, public hearing and DCRPC meeting; and (5) Resolution RPC No. 843, adopting the amendment.

We would appreciate your review and approval of this amendment to the *Dane County Water Quality Plan*. If you have any questions or need additional information or assistance in reviewing this amendment, please do not hesitate to contact me.

SUBJECT: Amendment to the Cross Plains Service Area of the Dane County Water Quality Plan

Dear Mr. Lane:


We have completed our review of the Village of Cross Plains amendment to the Cross Plains Urban Service Area boundary in the Dane County Water Quality Plan. This amendment adds 6 acres to the urban service area, removes 13.7 acres of existing environmental corridor adjacent to the Black Earth Creek floodway and adds 1.6 acres of new corridor. This project involves the development of subdivision plans and stormwater controls that are designed to remove up to 80 percent of pollutants from the development site. These controls should be sufficient to protect Black Earth Creek, a high quality resource. Stormwater runoff and erosion controls will have to be properly installed and maintained to protect surface and ground water quality.

The approval of this revision does not constitute approval of any of the following:

- o private sewage systems pursuant to Chapter ILHR 83, (WI Admin. Code),
- o sewer extension pursuant to Chapter NR 110, (WI Admin. Code),
- o authority to alter the bed or banks of any navigable waterway (Chapter 30, WI Stats.),
- o certification for any wetland alteration (Section 401, Federal Water Pollution Control Act, and NR 103, 299, WI Admin. Code).

Those approvals must be obtained separately from the respective agencies. In addition, storm water management plan development is required for any construction site activity disturbing five or more acres of land pursuant to Chapter NR 216 (WI Admin. Code). Any person aggrieved by this approval has the right to appeal the decision. Wisconsin Statutes and Administrative Code establish time periods within which requests to review Department decisions must be filed. For judicial review of a decision pursuant to s. 227.52 and 227.53, Wisconsin Statutes, a petition for review must be filed within 30 days after service of the decision. The respondent in an action for judicial review is the Department of Natural Resources. This notice is provided pursuant to s. 227.48(20), Wisconsin Statutes.
