

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 30-115 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF

The common council of the City of Tomah do ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 30-115(c) of the Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:


30-115(c) No wake zones on Lake Tomah:

1. That area southeast of a line delineated across the mouth of the Winnebago Park bay and marked by a single buoy in its center.
2. That area southwest of a line delineated by 9 waterway marker buoys and two land-based coordinates with Global Positioning Coordinates shown in the table below.



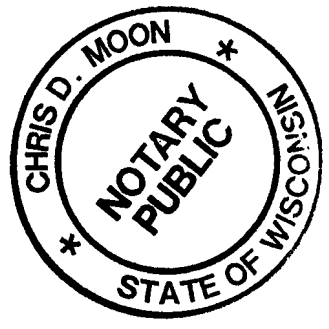
